## PRESIDENT AKUFO-ADDO MAKES NEW DEPUTY MINISTERIAL APPOINTMENTS

The President of the Republic, Nana Addo Dankwa Akufo-Addo, has reassigned the Deputy Minister for Trade and Industry and Member of Parliament for Nhyiaeso, **Hon. Stephen Amoah, as Deputy Minister for Finance**. Hon. Stephen Amoah, until his redesignation, was the Deputy Minister for Trade and Industry, and he takes over from the late Hon. John Kumah, who passed away on 7<sup>th</sup> March 2024. His appointment takes effect immediately.

Following the reassigment of Hon. Stephen Amoah as Deputy Minister for Finance, President Akufo-Addo has appointed, subject to parliamentary approval, **Hon. Kofi Ahenkorah Marfo**, Member of Parliament for Achiase, as **Deputy Minister-designate for Trade and Industry**. President Akufo-Addo is hopeful that Parliament will, once again, on a bi-partisan basis, expedite the approval of his nominee, so he can join the Government forthwith, and assist in the delivery of his mandate for his second term in office.
